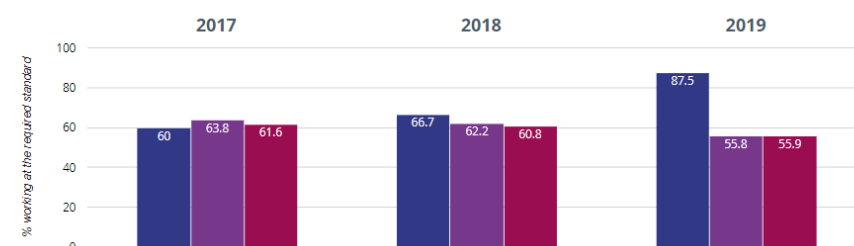

Phonics screening results

Key points:

- Year 1 phonics attainment results dropped by 0.6 percentage points compared to last year
- 71% of disadvantaged pupils met the expected standard in year 1
- 43% of pupils with SEN and/or disabilities met the expected standard in year 1

Year 1	82%	78%	85%
Year 2	91%	89%	94%

KS1 results - expected standard

Key points:

- Results are broadly similar to last year

Subjects (teacher assessed)	Overall	Boys	Girls
Reading	75%	71%	79%
Writing	69%	63%	76%
Maths	76%	74%	77%

Compared to last year, the gap between disadvantaged pupils and their peers is broadly the same. This is also the same for the gap between pupils with SEN and/or disabilities and their peers.

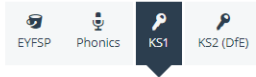
KS1 results - greater depth

Key points:

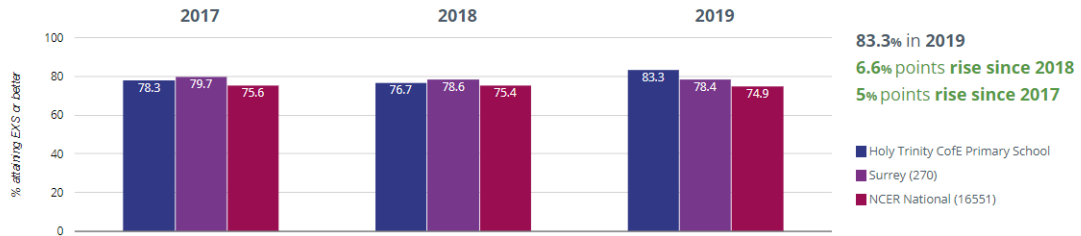
- 25% of all pupils achieved greater depth in reading
- Boys outperformed girls in maths by 5 percentage points
- Girls outperformed boys in reading (7 percentage points) and writing (8 percentage points)

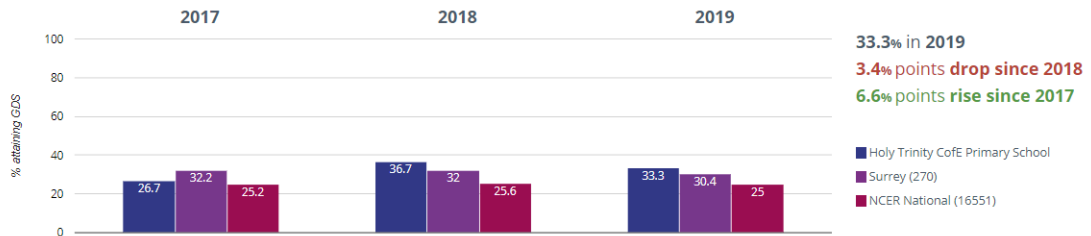

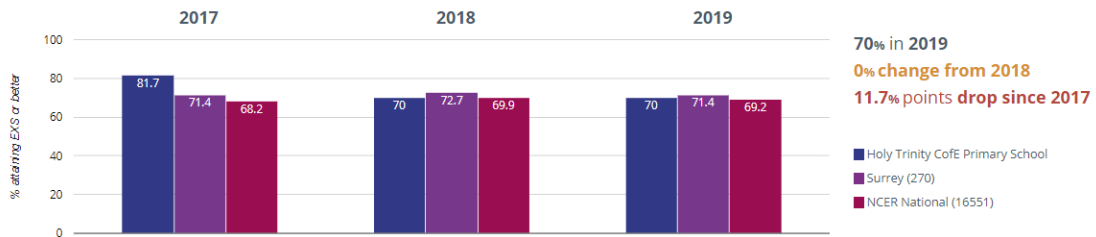
Reading - attaining EXS or better



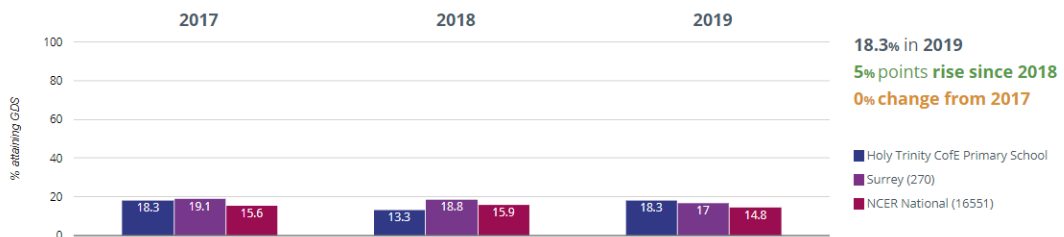
Reading - attaining GDS



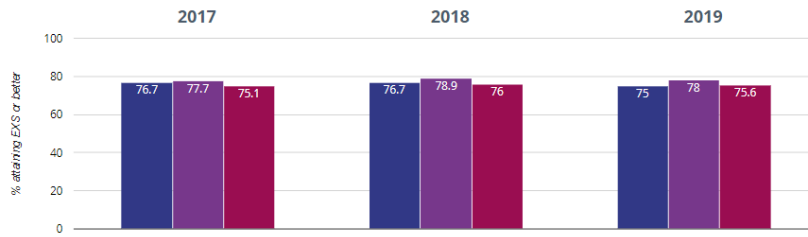
Writing - attaining EXS or better

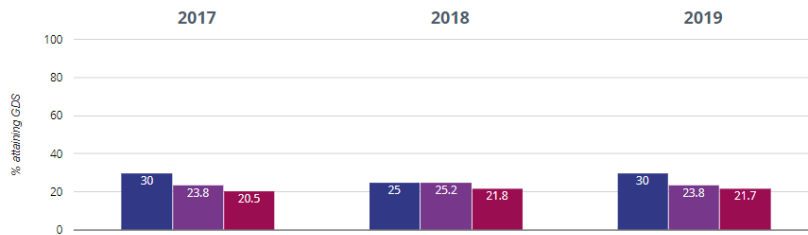

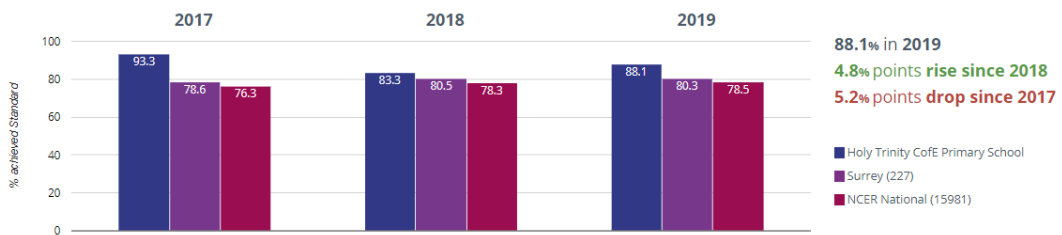
Reading - high attainers



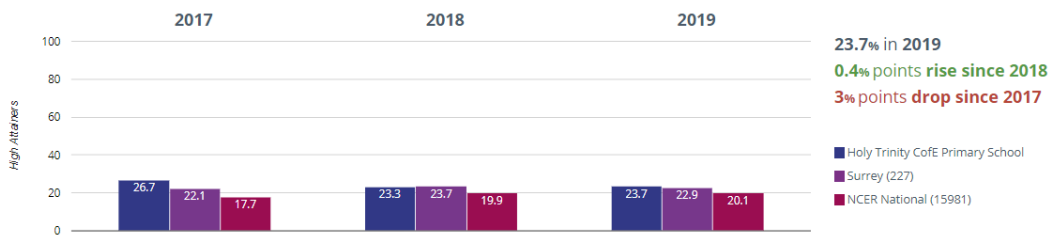
Reading - average scaled score



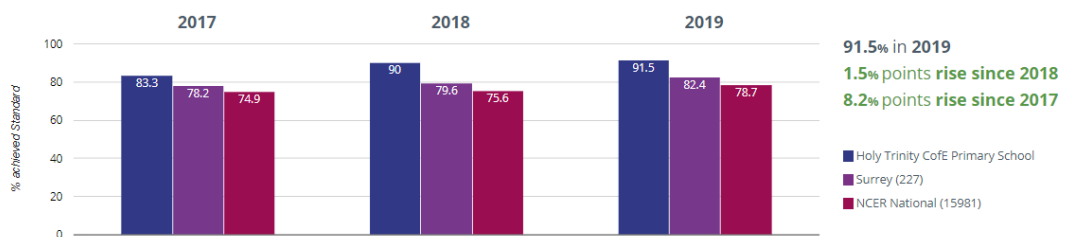

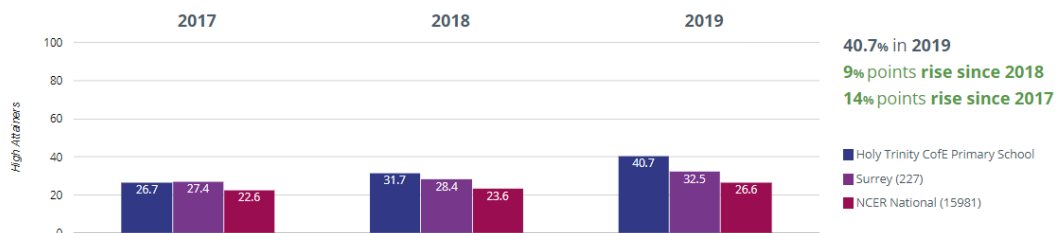
